

## HYMN NOTES:

### “Fight the Good Fight” (846)

The hymn, by John Monsell (1811-1875), was first published in in London in 1863. Based on I Timothy 6:12, the text was titled “The Fight of Faith.” This opening line has been misunderstood as a military image but is actually an athletic one, drawn from a Greek verb meaning “struggle” or “grapple” or “wrestle.” The sports context continues in later stanzas reflecting the experience of a runner. Monsell probably borrowed the idea for this hymn from another hymnwriter, James Montgomery had written ten years earlier:

*Fight the good fight; lay hold upon eternal life;  
Keep but thy shield, be bold, stand through the hottest strife;  
Invincible while in the field, thou canst not fail, unless thou yield.*

This earlier Montgomery hymn continues the military image throughout while Monsell’s very unlike it seems written as a ‘corrective.’ The hymn we sing today has appeared in over 400 hymnals through to the present day. Montgomery’s hymn last appeared in 1878.
