

HYMN NOTES: "As Those of Old Their Firstfruits Brought (712)

Written in 1960, this text by Presbyterian pastor Frank von Christierson (1900-1996) was first published in *Ten Stewardship Hymns* by the Hymn Society of America. The original first line, "As men of old their first fruits..." was altered by Christierson to "As saints of old their first fruits..." For the *Lutheran Book of Worship* (1978). The word "those" in the line that we sing is from *The Hymnal 1982* (Episcopal). On this text Christierson wrote: as pastor of two small churches with small memberships and great financial needs, I have been deeply concerned with stewardship, also because I am deeply concerned about missions and the outreach of the church to "all the world," also because stewardship is a very important phase of the Christian life. No one is deeply Christian until he (she) is a "good steward."

Born on Christmas Day in Finland in a house previously owned by the composer Jan Sibelius (*Finlandia*), Christierson served several Presbyterian churches in California.

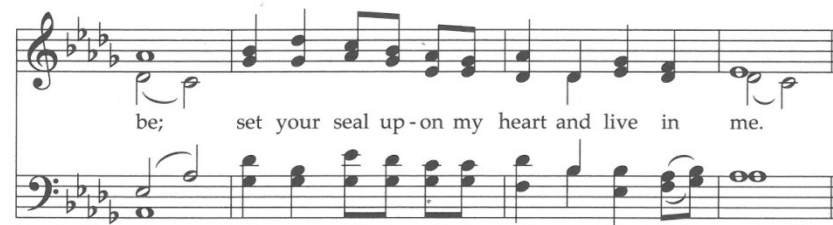
